School Site Council (SSC) - July 30, 2019

Minutes

- 1** Call to Order Alvillar called meeting at 3:02
- 2** Roll Call for Membership
 - Watson, Alvillar, Rincon, Anderson, Cardona, Estrada, Verdugo,
 - Community member - Janneth Reyes, Alina Perez (kinder parent)
- 3** Approval of the Agenda
 - Switch items 5 and 6 on the agenda
 - Anderson motioned; Cardona seconded. No discussion. Unanimous passage.
- 4** Approval of Minutes for May 14, 2019 Meeting
 - Anderson motioned; Cardona seconded. No discussion. Unanimous passage.
- 5** Principal Report
 - Library mold has been resolved. 17,000 books were discarded. The school will spend \$70,000 on new books, amounting to 4050 new titles.
 - MakerSpace will be housed in the library. Teachers/students will have weekly 30-40 minutes access to the library on Monday, Tuesday or Friday. Library will be accessible by the end of quarter 1 or beginning of quarter 2
 - Enrollment is 531; a new classroom was added (K-1)
 - SWISS Behavioral Referral Online is now in place; We will be able to look at data to better support our students
 - Morning Mileage Club starts next week (first week in August) at 7:30-7:55
 - GLAD Certification for Ms. Lee and Mrs. Galvez will happen over Fall break
 - Budget considerations: certification for both teachers will cost \$500 each (Jan 16-17); trainer certifying teacher will cost \$5,500 which covers all expenses associated with travel; trainer certification is \$1250; binders for attendees cost \$45 (8 currently enrolled), Spanish addendum is \$20; total amount needed is \$8,500
 - LM almost done, CAASPP still ongoing, as well as students taking Spanish CAASPP this year grades 3-6 for baseline data.
 - School Site Council Bylaws; binders need to be updated
 - Duties of council members: develop and approve a plan and related expenditures compliant with all regulations
 - Review Single Plan for Student Achievement
 - Members: 3 classroom teachers (need to add an alternate member), 1 staff, 5 parents; will be contemplating adding an alternate teacher and parent; elections of new parent member will be till next meeting
 - New staff: PE, Speech, 5th grade DI teacher; will be interviewing for 3rd DI-Spanish (Buelna)
 - DAC/DELAC reps: need to elect a parent to represent us at DAC/DELAC
 - Anderson will fill in until a member is found
 - Voting will be done on curriculum night

- Safety plan:
 - End of August are the next steps
 - Hazard and vulnerability Assessment training: Bree will attend meeting on Fri
- School Site Council Parent Member training
 - Bree will attend on the August 9th at 9:30 with Cardona
 - Charlene will attend the evening session, 6:00-7:30

6 Budget update

- Bree provided draft of 2019-2020 budget (doc 1)
 - Carryover amount is not included
 - Site budget allocation for Counselor, VAPA, Math resource teacher, instructional supplies, etc.
- Bree provided last year's ending budget 2018-2019 (doc 2)
 - Estimated allocations are on page 2
 - Adjustments with noon duties: eating outside, supervision is working out ok
- Need to allocate funds to support upper grade and DI teachers
 - Subs for extra planning/assessment time;
 - Bree will revisit the 3 proposed scenarios at next meeting (leaning towards the 2nd)
 - Since our school is fully committed to implement a DI program, efforts will be made to promote both languages:
 - Pledge of Allegiance will be recited in both languages @ assemblies;
 - To promote cultural diversity and world knowledge, grade levels will be assigned a continent; as students move through the grades, they will learn about that part of the world; DI-Spanish teachers will be encouraged to focus on a Spanish speaking country found in their continent.
 - Multi-cultural fair is planned in March
 - Tutoring, push-in support, after school, IEP support
 - DI Committee will meet once a month
- Imagine Learning Español \$10,000 yearly site license
 - New features prek-2, twice the content
 - Online reports, Web based
 - Motion to allocate funds Salome; Cardona second. No discussion. Unanimous passage.

 - Math training for teachers is being held this and next week
 - Subs were secured
