Dear CVESD Families,

As we enter our second semester, keeping our children safe and schools open are our top priorities. Chula Vista Elementary School District would like to send out a newsletter each week to ensure our community is updated on new COVID-19 guidance, processes, and procedures along with other areas of safety that we want to address.

NEW GROUP CONTACT TRACING

With more positive cases in the community, we are seeing more students and staff who are communicable on campus. Additionally, there is a more transmissible variant circulating so the County of San Diego/California Department of Public Health (CDPH) has recommended changes to the old process of student close contact tracing and a move to a group tracing protocol. All students exposed to a positive case (indoors for 15 minutes or more) are required to test day 3, 4 or 5 after the exposure to continue attending school/extracurriculars. This guidance applies to all TK-12 students regardless of vaccination status or prior COVID-19 infection. Parents are required to report all positive COVID-19 tests and any symptoms in their student to the school. Parents who do not want to have their children tested after exposure must keep them home for 10 days. This new guidance only applies to students exposed indoors at school, it does not apply to preschool children or staff.

NEW TESTING OPPORTUNITIES

The new group tracing model CVESD has adopted requires more student testing. To increase access, we have partnered with COVID Clinic to offer three kiosk PCR testing sites. These sites are in addition to our testing locations at the District Office and Hedenkamp Elementary. As you did with Primary Health, please look for a sign-up link from COVID Clinic to access this testing. We now have testing available at various CVESD sites Monday through Friday.

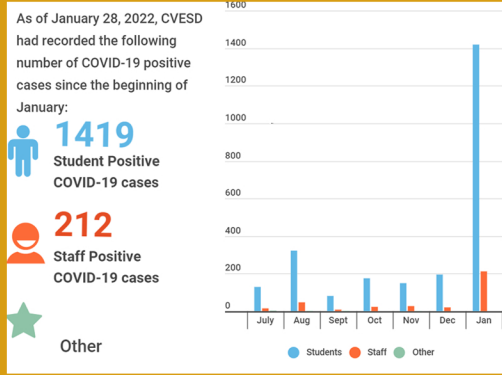
As a reminder, if your child is exposed to a person with COVID at school and required to test AND has had COVID-19 in the past 90-days, the recommended test is an antigen, not a PCR. Currently, antigen tests are only available at the District and Hedenkamp Elementary School locations. Home tests are allowed for students.
